Manager Needed for Tuxedo Farmers' Market

A dedicated produce-lover is being sought to manage the Tuxedo Farmers' Market, starting July through November 21st.

The Market Manager is responsible for overall operations and overseeing the vendors. This manager must build a good working relationship with the volunteers on the Farmers' Market board, as well as the vendors that supply the market.

This includes possible travel to do inspections of the farmers' fields to check out their operations and ensure they are actually producing the fresh goods they bring to sell in Tuxedo (Growers are primarily from Orange County, NY.) Some of the additional responsibilities include planning and running market events, advertising, social media posting and attending meetings to report updates.

Tuxedo residents are welcome to apply and encouraged to spread the word. Our Current market manger works at the Sloatsburg Library and one of our previous market managers was a retired School Teacher. Being a morning person is a desirable qualification, since the managers have to be on-site to oversee vendors as they set up before the market opens to the day's customers.

The Farmers' Market is open during the season from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. every Saturday in the Train Station parking lot on Route 17, in Tuxedo NY.

The Tuxedo Market is starting it's 11th season. Our Vendors offer a variety of produce, eggs, meats, breads, pies, pastries, flowers (fresh cut flowers, plants & herbs), pizza, fruit, jams, prepared foods, honey & cheese.
